Youth Employment – YICT Leader

Keewaytinook Okimakanak's Kuhkenah Network (KO-KNet) is Ontario's IT Regional Management Organization (RMO) for Aboriginal and Northern Affairs Canada's First Nation SchoolNet program. As part of the RMO work, we are working with the First Nation's schools & communities to train youth in retaining ICT skills that will prepare them for possible future ICT career endeavors in their community.

Duration: To March 30, 2012 (possible 10 week duration, if hiring is completed this week)

Eligibility Requirements:

- First Nations person residing on Reserve.
- Between the ages of 15 to 29 (inclusive).
- Legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations
- Reliable and Dependable person who is willing to devote all the time necessary to learn new ICT skills and perform the tasks assigned by both their local supervisor/community contact and the KO-KNet team.
- Must be eligible in working within the First Nation school facility and with other youth.

Duties include:

- Willing to learn new multi-media and computer skills
- Participating in the training provided
- Be a leader for the project within their community/
- Work with school and community organizations to support a class video project
- Ensure that all education staff and community members are aware of the video project
- Participate in discussion forums, Video Conferences, On-line meetings, and other ICT training sessions
- Ensure that all reporting requirements (Statistical forms and Youth Report) are completed and submitted on a timely basis and as directed
- Other duties as assigned by local supervisor and local office.
